Drafting the Mystery: Why AI's V2 Beat Human's V1

Human V1 (Predictable)

- ★ Spy Movie Villain
- ★ Motives fit neatly into isolated boxes
- ★ The player feels like a detached, external detective

Claude Code V2 (Brilliant)

- ★ Systemic Human Carelessness
- ★ Accidental public Wi-Fi leaks (like our CFO here)
- ★ The player is confronted with overlapping institutional failures

The AI correctly critiqued the original draft as solid but predictable, engineering a much deeper human tragedy based on everyday negligence rather than cinematic malice.

The Architecture of a Leak



There is no single mole. The true villain is a chain of human carelessness and broken protocols that handed the adversary everything.

Node A: CFO checks financial models on unencrypted Public Wi-Fi.



Node B: CTO mentions patent gaps during a job interview.

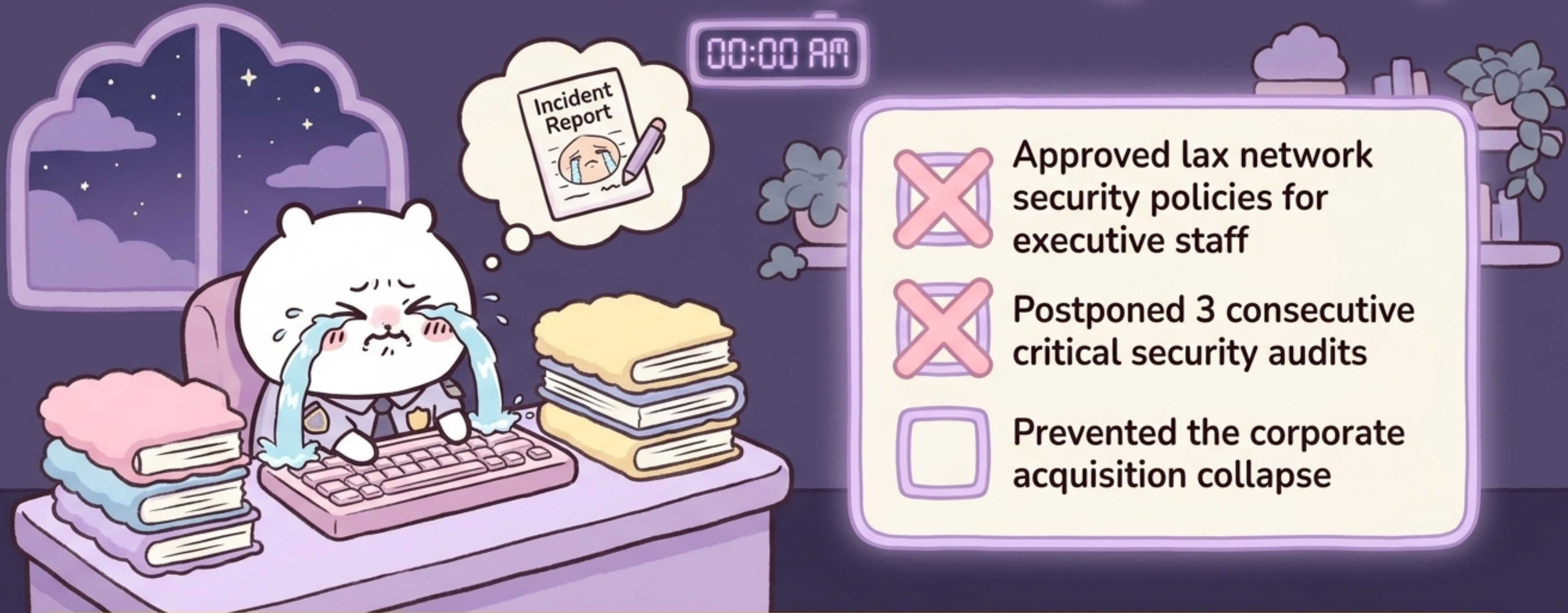


Node C: VP Sales smugly leaks the floor price over coffee.



Result: The adversary intercepts and pieces the fragments together.

The Mirror Moment: Implicating the Player



The game doesn't end with you catching a spy. It ends with you writing an incident report, acknowledging that your systemic negligence caused the vulnerabilities in the first place.
