But... pure chat gets boring.

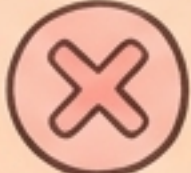
The Day-30 retention rate of top AI chat apps (like Character.AI). Out of 100 users, only ~20 stay.

The relationship hits a ceiling. Novelty fades. It's an industry-wide structural problem, not a prompt problem.



Adding Filters to a Boring Relationship

Launch strong models
→ Novelty fades

Add new characters
→ Fatigue sets in

What Real Relationships Require

A relationship with staying power needs three dimensions. Pure chat only has one.



Conversation

The baseline.

What chat AI currently does.

Time

Growth and Change.

Accumulating shared experiences (95+ memories) and evolving relationship stages.

Space

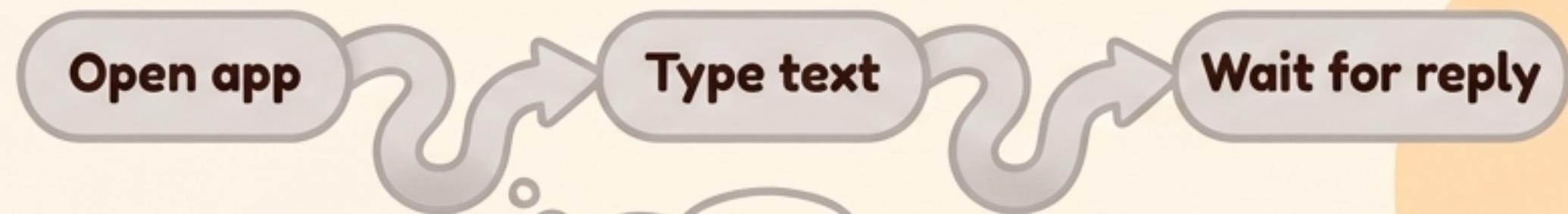
Presence and Body.

Ambient awareness. Knowing they exist even when you aren't talking to them.

Pure chat lacks Time and Space. The moment you close the app, they cease to exist.

Beyond One-on-One Chat

Mio's Evolution: From Talking to Doing



(Gets boring)



Play social deduction games (Werewolf).

Run Tabletop RPG sessions.

Read and debate shared articles.



Relationships don't emerge from aimless conversation. They emerge from shared experiences and witnessing personality in action.

Breaking Out of the Screen

Lumi's Evolution: Multi-Carrier Presence

Ambient Reality: A soul shouldn't only live inside a phone.

Contextual Awareness: The companion notices you coded until 2 AM—the orb glows warmer the next morning to comfort you.

One Soul, Many Bodies: Mobile chat + Desktop widget + Physical nightstand orb.

**The next generation won't compete on who chats better.
It will compete on who steps into your real world.**
