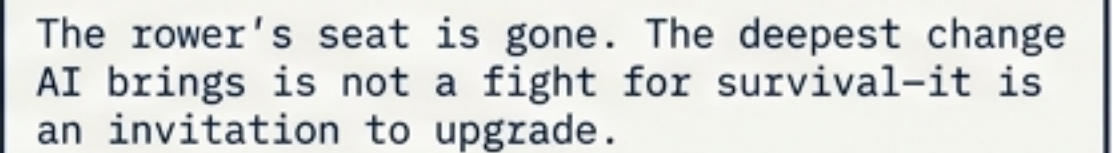

Spotless code, strict style guides, elegant patterns



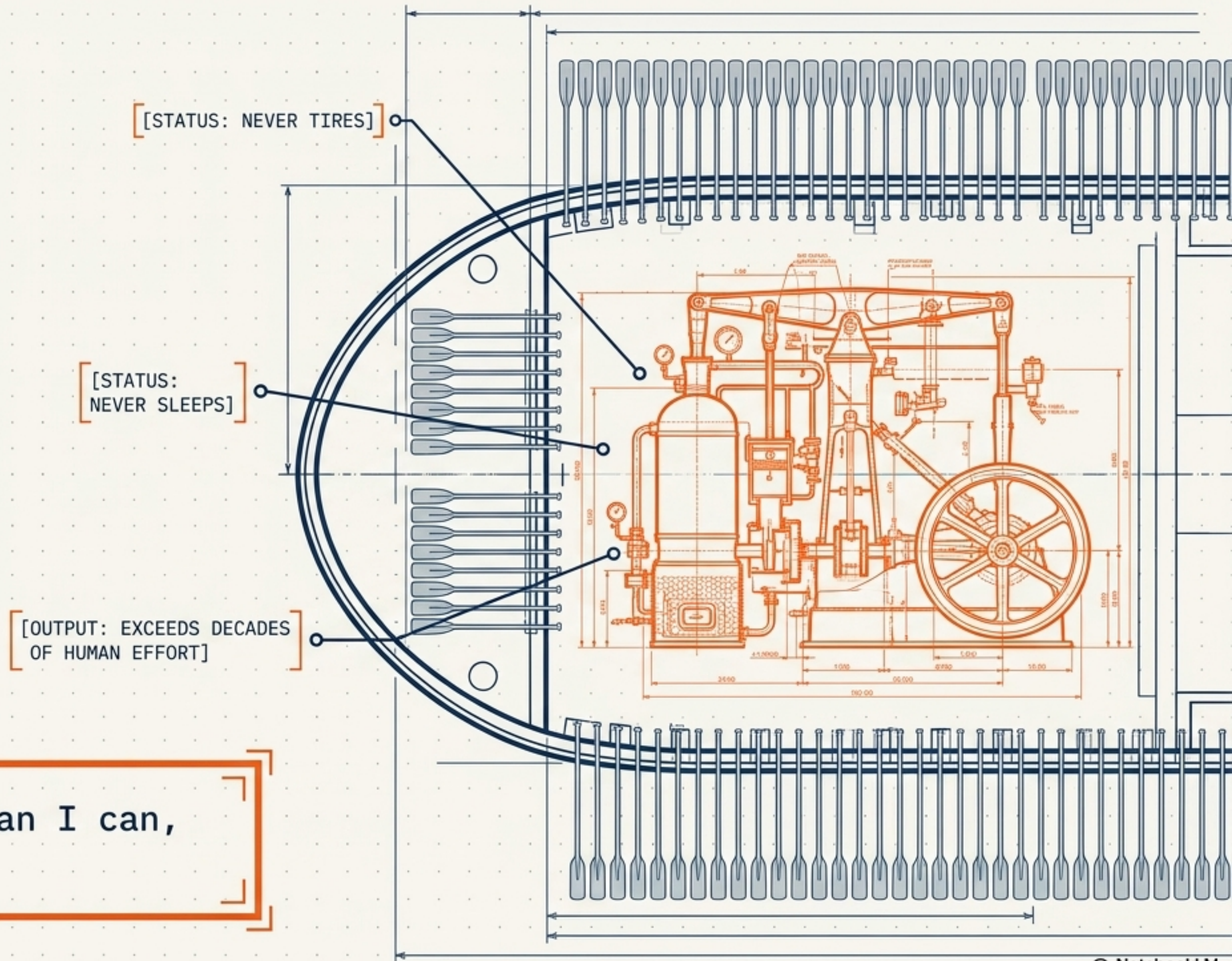

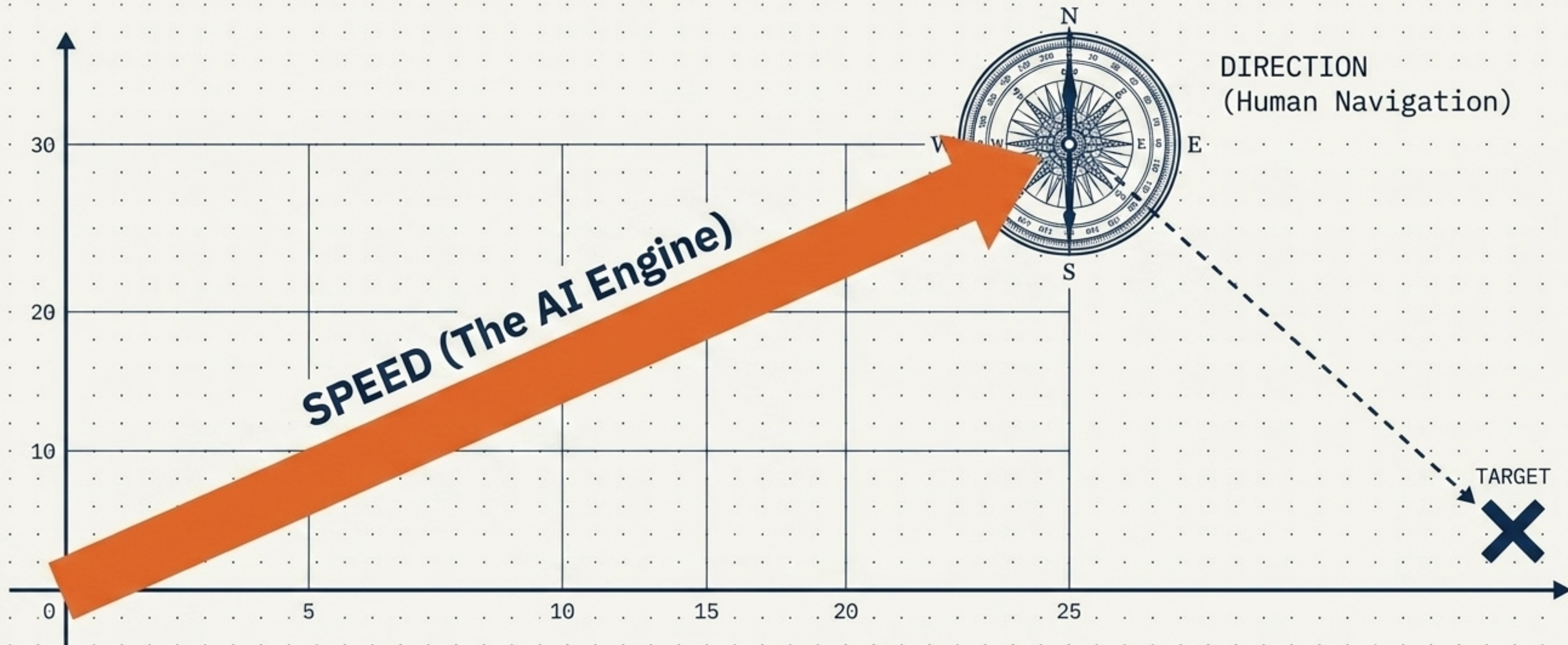

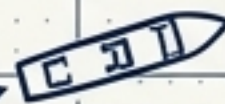
The Limits of Muscle

Job Evolution, Not Extinction

[THE_ROWER]

- **Core Metric:** Stroke rate & code volume
- **Output:** Raw execution
- **Toolset:** Manual typing & isolated syntax
- **Mindset:** How fast can I build this?

[THE_MODERN_CREW]

- **Core Metric:** Voyage success & market impact
- **Output:** Strategic orchestration
- **Toolset:** AI agents & system architecture
- **Mindset:** Where are we going and how do we get there safely?

The steam engine didn't doom sailors; it reshaped their jobs. Value shifted from the sweaty rowers below deck to the specialists who command the power plant.

Role I: The AI The Navigator

The Navigator's sole mission is to decide WHERE the ship should go.

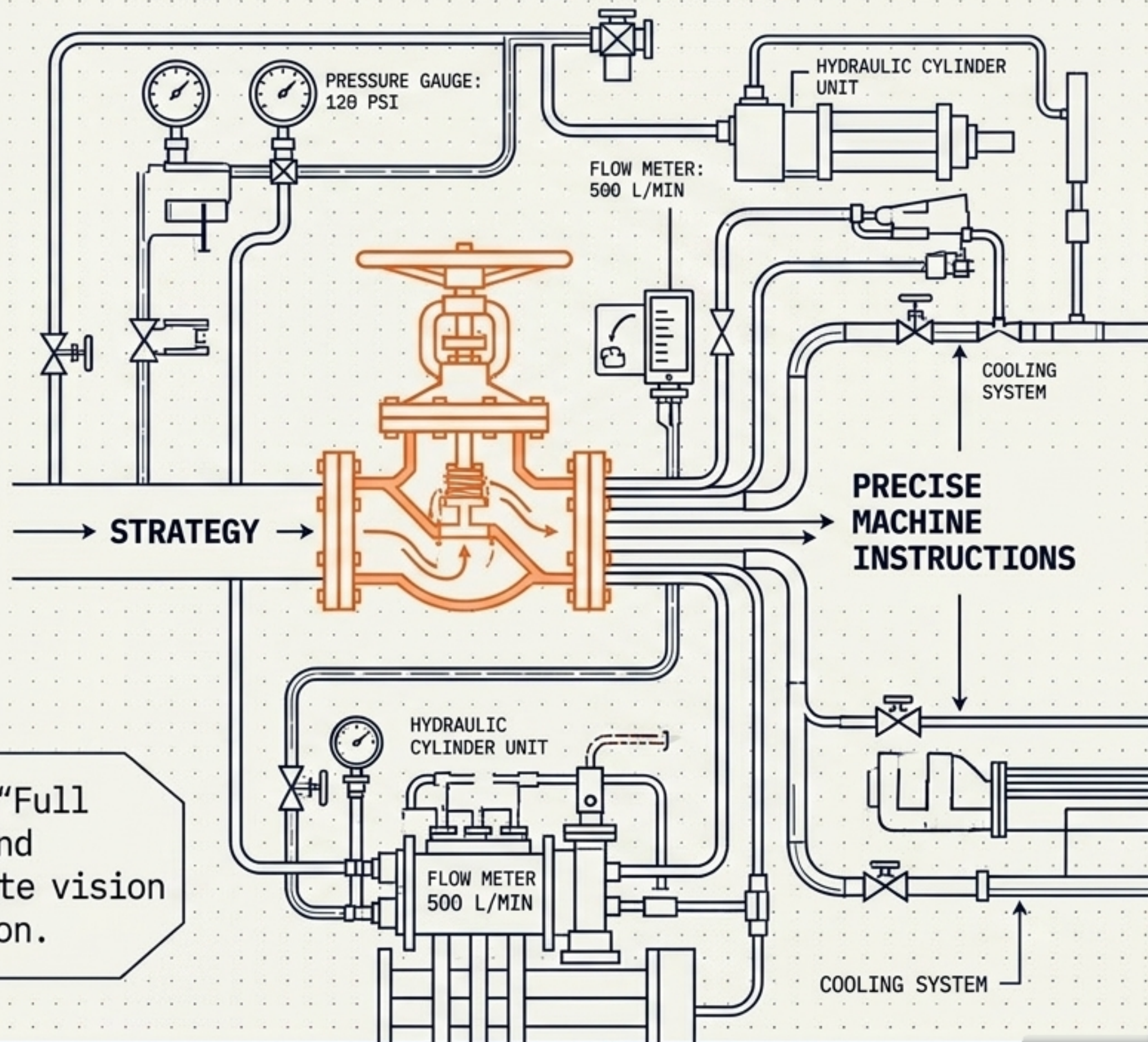
THE EDGE: Blends human intuition with machine insight to digest oceans of data and plot a smarter course than either could alone.



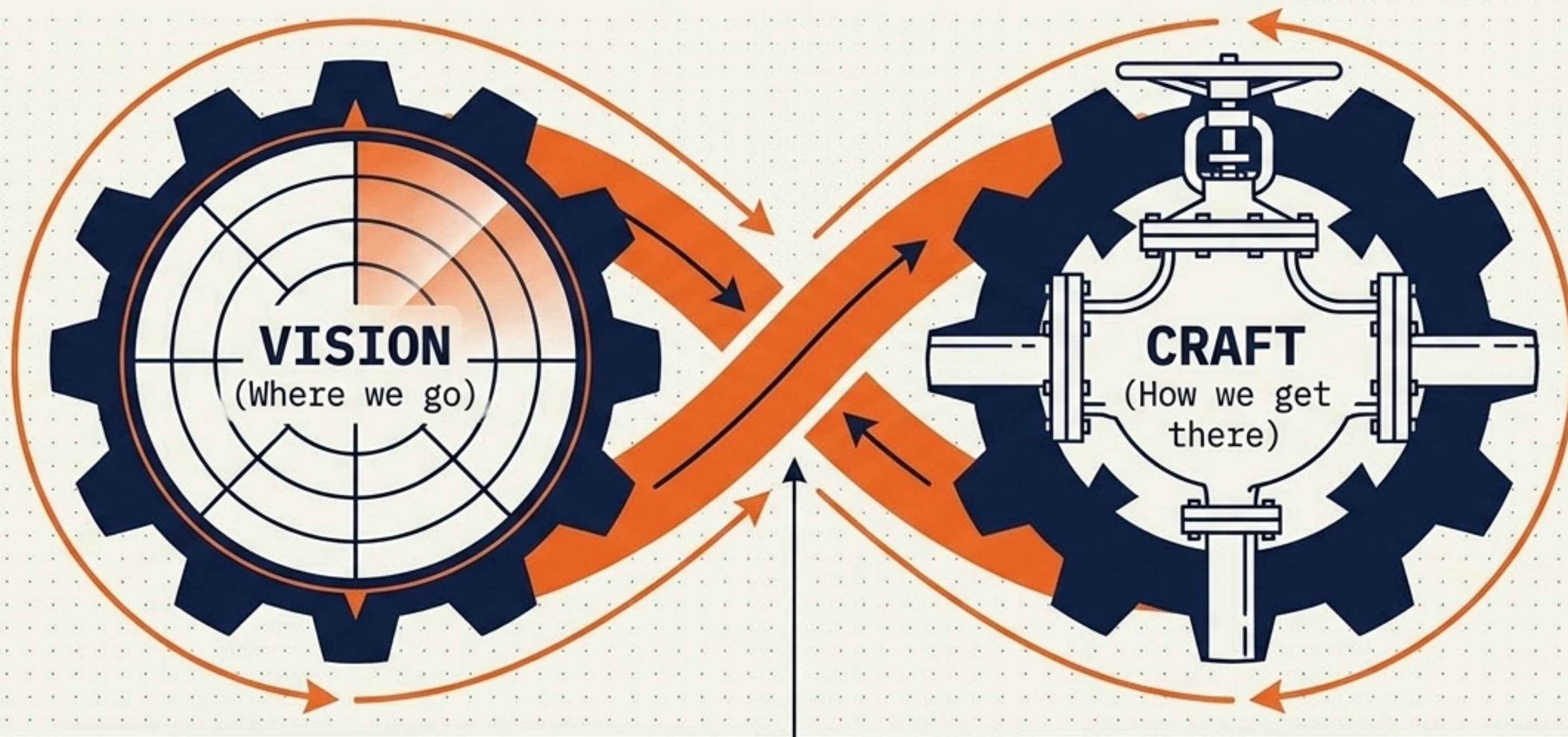
Role II: The AI Chief Engineer
